The Bark (vegan and gluten-free options *not safe for celiac) | dive bar vibe at night

Gaines Street Pies (very yummy pizza; dairy & gluten free options, safe for celiac)

<u>Black Radish</u> (if you're looking to treat yourself one night; vegetable forward menu, natural wine bar) *will have to Uber/Lyft from hotel.

Places to gather at night:

Bar 1903 (renovated old library; reasonably priced period specific cocktails and little eats)

The Bark (see above)

Charlie Park (roof top bar, slightly pricey side)

<u>Liberty bar and restaurant</u> (American food, good drinks/they make a mean mocktail too, nice environment for big groups)

If you are staying in town and looking for something to do:

<u>Wakulla Springs</u> (recommend the boat tour, you'll have to make a reservation beforehand) - you'll see lots of alligators!

<u>St. George Island</u> (you will need a rental car but a beautiful beach/national park about a 2-hour drive)

<u>Alfred B. McClay Gardens State Park</u> (in town, pretty to walk around)
